

Pediatric Narrow Complex Tachycardia

Designation of Condition: The patient will have a rapid heart rate (infant heart rate usually >220 bpm; child heart rate usually >180 bpm). The monitor will show a narrow QRS complex rhythm (<0.12 sec) without P waves. Signs and symptoms may include: Altered mentation, cyanosis, diaphoresis, mottled skin, tachypnea.
