

Nasal Drug Delivery Device

Indication: Patients requiring rapid medication administration when other routes of administration are not immediately available. Consider using intranasal route as first-line when attempting to minimize scene time.

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PROCEDURE:

1. Draw appropriate dose of medication into syringe.
2. Attach mucosal atomization device (MAD) to syringe.
3. Aerosolize the medication into each of the patient's nostrils (limit of 1.0 mL per nostril).
4. Dispose of used syringe in a biohazard sharps container.
