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| BLS Treatment |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assess circulation, airway, breathing, and responsiveness.• If HR < 60, START CPR.• Oxygen as indicated.• Provide Spinal Motion Restriction as indicated or position of comfort as indicated.• Appropriately splint suspected fractures/instability as indicated.• Bandage wounds/control bleeding as indicated. |
| ALS Treatment |
| <p>Current American Heart Association Guidelines concerning Emergency Cardiac Care assessments and interventions shall always take precedence over local protocols when there is a conflict concerning techniques of resuscitation.</p> |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Defibrillation• Advanced airway if indicated.• Epinephrine• IV/ IO Normal Saline fluid bolus.• Amiodarone |
