

## 2.13 ADULT SEIZURE

<b>BLS Treatment</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Position of comfort.</li><li>• NPO</li><li>• <b>Oxygen</b> as indicated.</li></ul>
<b>ALS Treatment</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Advanced airway management as indicated.</li><li>• Status epilepticus is continuous seizure activity lasting &gt; 5 minutes OR multiple seizures without regaining consciousness between seizures. SBP &gt; 90, administer: <b>Midazolam</b></li><li>• Establish IV/IO access with <b>Normal Saline</b> TKO.</li><li>• If BGL &lt; 60 mg/dl, <b>Dextrose</b> IV/IO. Repeat as needed. If IV cannot be established, administer <b>Glucagon</b>.</li><li>• For suspected narcotic overdose with respiratory depression or failure and/or shock, administer <b>Naloxone</b>.</li></ul>
<b>Base Hospital Contact Criteria</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Additional <b>Midazolam</b> administration beyond max dose needed for patient with continued seizures.</li></ul>
