Subject: COVID-19 Augmentation of Policy 5000.1 for CPMC-Bernal (Obstetrics)

On March 20, 2020 an EMS Memo was issued regarding the suspension of Obstetrics patients transported to CPMC-Bernal by EMS:

"...CPMC Mission Bernal Obstetrics (OB) Specialty Destination is suspended indefinitely for COVID-19 response re-purposing. Please redirect OB patients intending to be transported to CPMC Mission Bernal to another OB-receiving hospital."

As a reminder, this direction is still in effect. An augmented version of the hospital designation chart in Policy 5000.1 is attached reflecting this change.
